## PROTECTION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

*This privacy statement provides information about the processing and the protection of your personal data*

**Processing operation:** Processing of personal data linked to the IRIS<sup>2</sup> Info Days on April 2026

### Data Controller:

**SpaceRISE consortium.** The SpaceRISE consortium is composed of: SES Astra S.A., a company incorporated under the laws of the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg, registered with the Trade and Companies Register of Luxembourg (R.C.S. Luxembourg) under number 22589 and having its registered office at Château de Betzdorf, L-6815, Betzdorf, Luxembourg (“**SES**”); EUTELSAT S.A., a company incorporated under the laws of France, registered with the Trade and Companies Register of Nanterre (R.C.S. Nanterre) under number 422 551 176 and having its registered office at 32 BD GALLIENI 92130 ISSY-LES-MOULINEAUX, France (“**Eutelsat**”); and HISPASAT, S.A., a company incorporated under the laws of Spain, registered with the Commercial Registry of Madrid under number ES-A79201075 and having its registered office at Albatros, Edificio B, Planta 4<sup>a</sup>, Calle Anabel Segura, 11, 28108 Alcobendas (Madrid), Spain (“**Hispasat**”) (hereinafter jointly referred as the “Data Controller”). The consortium members act as joint controllers with the same rights and obligations as data controllers for the purposes of the personal data processing hereunder.

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### 1. Introduction

The SpaceRISE consortium (hereinafter SpaceRISE) is committed to protect your personal data and to respect your privacy.

This privacy statement explains the reason for the processing of your personal data, the way we collect, handle and ensure protection of all personal data provided, how that information is used and what rights you have in relation to your personal data. It also specifies the contact details of the responsible Data Controller with whom you may exercise your rights and the Data Protection Officers.

The information in relation to processing of personal data linked to the IRIS<sup>2</sup> Info Days, organised by SpaceRISE.

## **2. Why and how do we process your personal data?**

SpaceRISE collects and further processes your personal data to:

- process your application to participate in the info day
- provide you with information about the info day (before, during and after)

Your personal data will not be used for any automated decision-making, including profiling.

Further, live web-streaming and audio-visual recording at the meeting or event of the speakers, organisers and participants, as well as photographs of the speakers and panoramic photographs of participants and organisers may be taken.

Please note that this meeting or event may be held using a third party videoconference IT service, such as Cisco Webex, which processes personal data.

## **3. On what legal ground(s) do we process your personal data?**

The processing operations on personal data, linked to the organisation, management, follow-up and promotion of the meeting or event (including web-streaming, photos, audio-visual recording) are necessary for the preparation, administration and follow-up after the Info Day(s).

We collect your personal data on the basis of your explicit consent as per Article 6 1 a) of the REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation or “GDPR”).

Your consent is also required for the following actions during the meeting or event (if applicable):

- the recording of the info day, including during the Question and Answers session;
- the processing of your personal data for inviting you to future related events the data controller may organise;

If you opt-in, you are giving us your explicit consent to process your personal data for those specific purposes. You can give your consent via a clear affirmative act by ticking the box on the online registration form.

## **4. Which personal data do we collect and further process?**

The following personal data may be processed in the context of the meeting or event:

- Contact details (function/title, first name, last name, name of organisation, city, country, e-mail address, telephone number);
- Nationality, passport or identity card number and its date of issue and expiry date may be collected, so that the data subjects may obtain access to the premises where the meeting or event is held. Such data shall be disclosed to the following entities: Agencia Espacial Española, Agenzia Spaziale Italiana, European Space Agency y Polska Agencja Kosmiczna. The Agencia Espacial Española will act as data processor on behalf of SpaceRISE and will process that data only for security purposes (granting access to the

premises). The remaining entities will act as data controllers for the purposes of carrying out access control to their respective premises.

- Audio-visual recording of the meeting, for establishing the attendance list and the minutes.

## 5. How long do we keep your personal data?

The Data Controller only keeps your personal data for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose of collection or further processing. For each of the categories of personal data that may be processed, please find below the retention details and the reference to the relevant record of processing:

- Personal data related to the organisation and management of the meeting or event (this includes the information given during the registration, before, during or after the event) will be kept for **one year** after the meeting or event.
- Sensitive personal data relating to access requirements will be deleted by The Agencia Espacial Española as soon as they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they have been collected in the framework of the meeting or event, but no later than within **1 month** after the end of the meeting or event. The remaining entities shall determine the retention periods as established by applicable law.

Selected service providers for organisational purposes (such as caterers, travel agents or event management organisations) are contractually bound to process personal data on behalf of and in line with the instructions of the Data Controller, keep confidential any data they process and protect it from unauthorised access, use and retention.

## 6. How do we protect and safeguard your personal data?

All personal data in electronic format (e-mails, documents, databases, uploaded batches of data, etc.) are stored on the servers of Hispasat or of its contractors, Hispasat acting as joint controller together with SES y Eutelsat for the purposes of organising the Infodays events (Digital Europe Programme). In order to protect your personal data, the Data Controller has put in place a number of technical and organisational measures. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access, taking into consideration the risk presented by the processing and the nature of the personal data being processed.

Organisational measures include restricting access to the personal data solely to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of this processing operation.

## 7. Who has access to your personal data and to whom is it disclosed?

Access to your personal data is provided to the SpaceRISE staff responsible for carrying out this processing operation and to other authorised staff according to the “need to know” principle. Such staff abide by statutory, and when required, additional confidentiality agreements.

## Cookies

Cookies are short text files stored on a user’s device (such as a computer, tablet or phone) by a website. Cookies are used for the technical functioning of a website (functional cookies) or for gathering statistics (analytical cookies).

Registration for the meeting takes place via a form website, the cookies employed by Hispasat on the registrant's device for that purpose will be covered by the cookie policy of Hispasat, which is available here: <https://www.hispasat.com/es/politica-de-cookies>

### **Third party IT tools, including Social Media**

We may use third party IT tools to inform about and promote the meeting or event through widely used communication channels, including the social media.

You may be able to watch our videos, which may be also uploaded to one of our social media pages and follow links from our website to other relevant social media.

In order to protect your privacy, our use of third party IT tools to connect to those services does not set cookies when our website pages are loaded on your computer (or other devices), nor are you immediately redirected to those social media or other websites. Only in the event that you click on a button or "play" on a video to watch it, a cookie of the social media company concerned will be installed on your device. If you do not click on any social media buttons or videos, no cookies will be installed on your device by third parties.

In order to view such third-party content on our websites, a message will alert you that you need to accept those third parties' specific Terms and Conditions, including their cookie policies, over which the Commission has no control.

We recommend that users carefully read the relevant privacy policies of the social media tools used: X (formerly known as Twitter). These explain each company's policy of personal data collection and further processing, their use of data, users' rights and the ways in which users can protect their privacy when using those services.

Please note that this meeting or event may be held using a third party videoconference IT service such as Cisco Webex. This IT tools has its own cookies and privacy policies over which SpaceRISE has a limited or no control. By participating into the meeting or event via a videoconference IT tool, the participants consent to the processing of their personal data via the third party tool as described in the related privacy policy.

The use of a third party IT tool does not in any way imply that SpaceRISE endorses them or their privacy policies. In the event that one or more third party IT tools are occasionally unavailable, we accept no responsibility for lack of service due to their downtime.

### **International transfers**

The information we collect will not be given to any third party, except as stated otherwise herein or except to the extent and for the purpose we may be required to do so by law.

### **8. What are your rights and how can you exercise them?**

You have specific rights as a 'data subject' under Chapter III of GDPR, in particular the right to access, rectify or erase your personal data and the right to restrict the processing of your personal data. Where applicable, you also have the right to object to the processing or the right to data portability.

If you have consented to provide your personal data to the data controller for the present processing operation, you can withdraw your consent at any time by notifying the Data Controller. The

withdrawal of your consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out before you have withdrawn the consent.

You can exercise your rights by contacting the Data Controller, or in case of conflict the Data Protection Officer. Their contact information is given under Heading 9 below.

Where you wish to exercise your rights in the context of one or several specific processing operations, please provide their description (i.e. their Record reference(s) as specified under Heading 10 below) in your request.

Any request for access to personal data will be handled within one month. Any other request mentioned above will be addressed within 15 working days.
